~More "hands on" activities, such as building a resume you can use, in a workshop







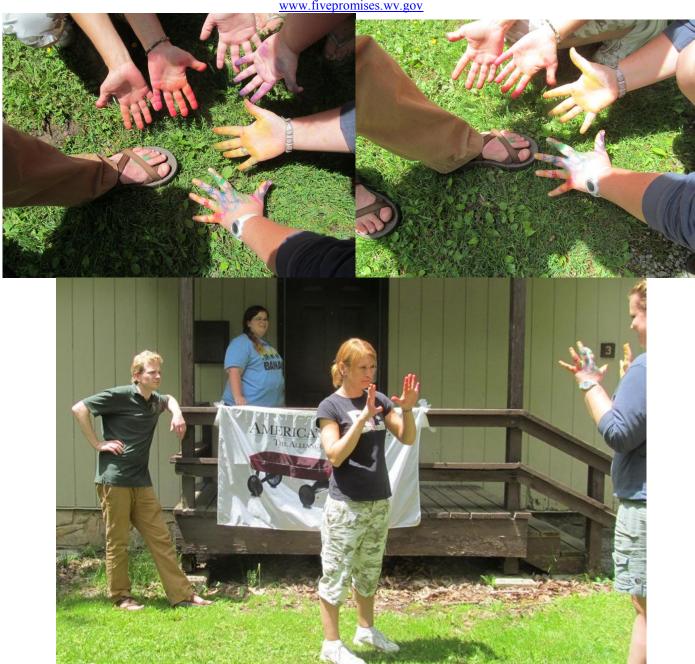
